RULES & REGULATIONS

TEAM REGISTRATION

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: SUNDAY, 21 APRIL

A deposit of RM200 is required to confirm your registration.

The deposit will be returned on Sunday 28 April

PLAYER REGISTRATION

Under 12 teams may register a maximum of 14 players

Under 14 and Under 16 teams may register a maximum of 18 players

On the day of the tournament, all players must have the following documents:

- Original IC **or** Original Passport

REGISTRATION PROCESS

Teams will be required to complete a Team Registration form (available in digital and paper formats) which lists all players' full names, their date of birth, and their IC number.

Online registration forms will be sent to teams before the tournament; paper forms will be available at the registration table.

On **both days of the tournament**, all players must come to the registration table with their **original IC or passport**.

After a player has shown their original identification they will receive a stamp on their hand which will allow them to play in the tournament.

Teams found using unregistered players will be disqualified from the competition.

For each age group players must be born after the following dates:

UNDER 12

Born January 1st 2007 and later

UNDER 14

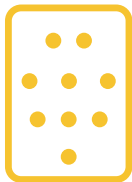
Born January 1st 2005 and later

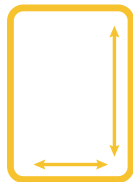

9 A SIDE



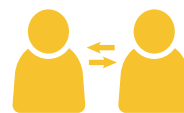

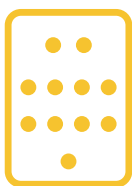

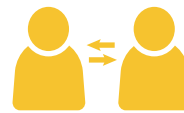

11 A SIDE



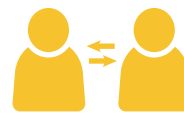

GENERAL INFORMATION

TEAM REPRESENTATIVES

All teams must have a dedicated coach/manager who is responsible for communication with the organisers

MATCHES

All matches will last 22-minute matches (no half time)

Teams will play matches on both Saturday & Sunday

Unless otherwise stated in the schedule, Group Stage matches will be played on Day 1 (Saturday) and Knockout Stage matches will be played on Day 2 (Sunday)

SUBSTITUTIONS

Substitutions can only be made with the referee's consent.

A substitute may only enter the field when the ball has gone out of play or in a dead ball situation, and only when the player being replaced has left the field.

Substitutions should be made from the team technical area.

PRIZES

Teams finishing 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each competition will receive a medal (1 per player)

Teams finishing in 1st place in each competition will also receive a trophy

TEAM RANKINGS

In the event that 2 or more teams are tied with the same number of points in the **Group Stages**, team placings will be determined by the following, in order:

- a) Goal Difference
- b) Goals scored
- c) Goals conceded
- d) Head to Head result
- e) Sudden death penalty shootout

PENALTY SHOOTOUTS

In the event a match is tied in the Knockout Stages, the game will move straight to a penalty shootout with the following rules:

- a) 3 penalties per team
- b) If teams are tied after 3 penalties, the match will move to sudden death penalties until 1 team scores and the other fails to score in the same round

Note: Penalties may only be taken by players who were on the field of play at the time of the final whistle (ie no substitutions after the match for the penalty shootout)

RULES

A full list of rules can be found at www.ipohcup.com and will be available at the registration table during the tournament. Some important rules and points to note are included below.

FIFA RULES

Standard FIFA 9-a-side and 11-a-side rules will be applied to all matches.

The offside rule will be in place for all Under 12, Under 14 and Under 16 matches.

REFEREE'S DECISION

Coaches, team managers and supporters shall not question the referee's decision.

CONDUCT

The use of foul language could lead to a team being removed from the tournament.

Please see our stance on player, coach and parent conduct below.

SUSPENSION

If a player receives a red card or 2 yellow cards in 1 match they will be banned for the next game.

WEATHER

If bad weather occurs during the tournament, the organisers have the right to make adjustments to the format and/or match times.

MEDICAL AND INSURANCE

A medical team will be on site to assist players with injuries, however all players must have their own medical insurance.

The organisers are not liable to any death, disability, personal injury, loss of property or any other loss howsoever arising from any cause whatsoever at any time during the course of this tournament.

The Organising team will take all reasonable precaution, but each player is responsible for his or her personal health and safety upon agreement to participate in this tournament.

CODE OF CONDUCT

The Ipoh Cup aims to provide a positive sporting environment for all players, parents and coaches. Therefore we require that all attendees follow the code of conduct listed below. Failure to comply could lead to disqualification from the tournament.

1.

Encourage members of both teams, and keep all comments positive.
Abusive or profane language will not be tolerated.

2.

Criticising or harassing the officials, coaches, opponents, or fans will not be tolerated.

3.

The use or consumption of alcohol, drugs or tobacco during games by the pitch is prohibited.

4.

You are responsible for all family members and friends attending games to watch your child.

5.

Parents shall never falsify their child's age in order that they be assigned to a certain league or team.

6.

Parents shall not engage in any attempt to scout another team's practices.

7.

Parents shall not pressure or harass the coaching staff regarding playing time for their child.

8.

Parents, players, and coaches will respect all coaches, referees and opponent players at all times, and will have sportsmanship as their number one priority in all games and practices.

9.

Coaches shall not disobey or attempt to circumvent league rules/regulations or their intent.

10.

Coaches shall not attempt to recruit or influence a player or parent to leave their current team.

11.

Coaches shall not engage in any attempt to scout another team's practices.

12.

Coaches shall not permit an injured player to enter or re-enter a game against the advice or consent of their parent or the safety committee volunteer on duty.
